## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

Fall/Spring 2017-2018

- (5) 3 hole, 1 subject, spiral notebooks, college ruled, perforated, 3 hole
- (6) 3 ring binders (for handouts) – no larger than 1 ½ in.
- (6) 5 or 8 tab section dividers – for placing into 3 ring binders
- (200) sheets loose-leaf paper – college ruled – for placing into binders
- (4) solid color plastic 2 pocket folders – (History)
- (1) BLACK plastic 2 pocket folder with brads – (Music)
- (1) pkg. lined 3 x 5 index cards (for use in many classes)
- (2) graph paper notebooks (perforated) or at least 250 pages of loose leaf graph paper with light lines – (Math)
- (1) 12" metric ruler – (Math, Art, Science – firm, not bendable)
- (1) 9"x12" or 8.5"x11" spiral or hard bound sketchbook - (Art)
- (12) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga or Forest Choice pencils, yellow, sharpened (Art)
- (6) Mechanical pencils preferred (Math, Science)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener (no sharpeners in the rooms)
- (2) rectangular erasers (pink pearl or white) – (Art and for use in other classes)
- (4) black ball-point pens – (all classes)
- (4) red ball-point pens – (Math, Science for making corrections)
- (4) EXPO black, fine tip dry erase marker – (Pre-algebra)
- (1) Highlighter pens – package of 4 – (All Classes)
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils – (not erasable or twist-up) - to be kept in locker until requested by teacher – (Art)
- (1) Set of 8 Crayola thin tipped washable markers - to be kept in locker until requested by teacher – (History)
- (2) Elmer's Glue sticks (Art)
- (1) Small stapler and staples
- (1) Zippered pencil case to hold supplies
- NO SHARPIES OR OTHER PERMANENT MARKERS
- **Calculator Notes from Mr. Moncada:**All 8<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students need a graphing calculator for math. Pay careful attention to these purchasing guidelines: As I will be teaching with a Texas Instruments model, it works best to buy any version of the TI-83, TI-84 or TI Nspire (non-CAS). **ABSOLUTELY DO NOT** purchase a TI-89, TI-92, TI-Nspire **CAS** (non-CAS is OK), or anything with a QWERTY keypad. These calculators have functions that are prohibited during standardized assessments. You are free to buy another brand (e.g. Casio, Sharp, HP); however, as we will be teaching based on the TI calculators and will be unable to provide support. Please contact your teacher before purchasing one of these brands to determine if it is acceptable. **ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE FORBIDDEN**
